



The Vail Health Howard Head Sports Residency Application 2019

Application submissions need to contain the following to be considered for review:

- Current Physical Therapy Licensure OR documentation demonstrating intent to sit for licensure prior to the start of the program, July 2019, i.e. proof of registration to sit for the April 2019 NPTE
- Current Emergency Medical Responder Certification, EMT Certification, and/or proof of certification as an Athletic Trainer or documentation demonstrating intent to obtain one of the above certifications, prior the start of the program, July 2019
- Current curriculum vitae
- Letter of Intent limited to 3000 characters:
 - Describe your specific interest in the Howard Head Sports Residency, not just sports residencies in general, as well as your career goals and objectives following graduation.
- 3 letters of recommendation
 - At least one must be from a licensed physical therapist who can comment on the applicant's skills, proficiency, and overall professionalism in a clinic environment
- Essay response limited to 9,000 characters answering the following question:

If you had the opportunity to bring someone you admire – past or present, fictional or nonfictional – to a place that is special to you (your hometown or country, a favorite location, etc.), who would you bring and why? Tell us what you would share with that person.



Interested individuals should submit applications through RF-PTCAS on or before Friday, January 11th, 2019.

Once applications are received and reviewed by HHSR Faculty, top candidates will be contacted by Friday, February 1st. These candidates will be offered the opportunity to interview at the Howard Head clinic in Vail on Monday, March 4th. The two residents selected for the 2019-2020 class will be notified within two weeks of the interview date.
