

## The Vail Health Howard Head Sports Residency Application 2018-2019

Application submissions need to contain the following to be considered for review:

- Howard Head Contact Information Summary
- Current Licensure or documentation demonstrating intent to sit for licensure prior to the start of the program, July 2018
- Current Emergency Medical Responder Certification, EMT Certification, and/or proof of certification
  as an Athletic Trainer or documentation demonstrating intent to obtain one of the above
  certifications, prior the start of the program, July 2018
- Current curriculum vitae
- Letter of Intent
  - Should describe your specific interest in the Howard Head Sports Residency, not just sports residencies in general, as well as your career goals and objectives following graduation
- 3 letters of recommendation
  - At least one must be from a licensed physical therapist who can comment on the applicant's skills, proficiency, and overall professionalism in a clinic environment
- Essay response limited to 5,000 characters answering the following question:

"What is the best compliment you have ever received and why?"
